NATIONAL INSURANCE SOLUTION



From 1 January 2024 the Export Credit Agency (ECA) is authorized to insure investments in Ukraine against war and political risks

9 April 2024 the government approved the list of war and political risks along with the **terms** and procedure governing their insurance by ECA

SUPPORT OF SIGNIFICANT INVESTMENT PROJECTS

SEPTEMBER 2023

Upgraded law, introducing new forms of the state support

Requirements for investors were defined

UA budget 2024 – allocated funds of UAH 3 bln

APRIL 2024

Implemented detailed rules for the state support

A project worth min EUR 12 million and lasting up to 5 years in designated areas

Reimbursement of costs for constructed engineering and transport infrastructure or connection to networks

Total amount of reimbursement could reach up to 30% of the investment

CURRENCY CONTROL REGIME IMPROVED 03 May 2024 National Bank of Ukraine substantially overhauled the existing regime of FX restrictions as per the Strategy for Easing FX Restrictions adopted by the NBU in 2023 Repatriation of new dividends is allowed if Many outbound FX transactions are now declared out of the business results since permitted 1st of January 2024 onwards monthly limit - equivalent of EUR 1 million

UKRAINE FACILITY ECONOMIC SUPPORT PROGRAM 2024 - 2027 for €50 billion

Direct support to the state budget: €38,27 billion

Investment fund: €6,97 billion

Technical and admin support: **€4,76 billion**
