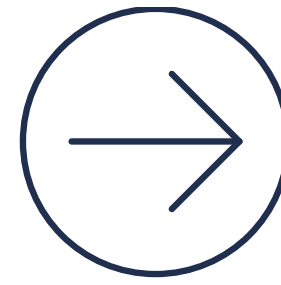

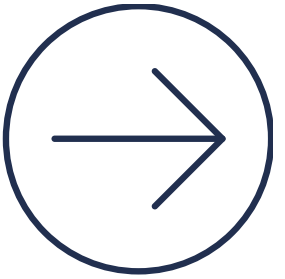

The trip to Washington DC, where we will join the 66th edition of the Philip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court International Rounds.

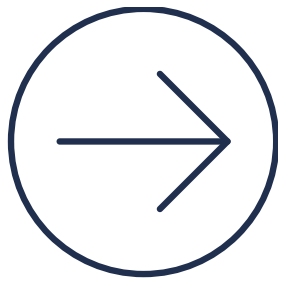
## **It is important for both you and us to support us because**

# National University of Kyiv-Mohyla Academy

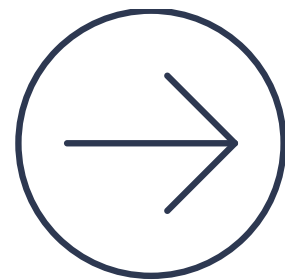
## History

3/4 members of the team came together in October 2024 to participate in the Telders International Law Moot Court Competition.

They **won the finals of the International Rounds in the ICJ becoming the second Ukrainian team ever winning the competition**. They also got the Best Applicant Memorial and Best Applicant Oral Advocacy Awards

In July 2024, the 2024 Telders Team co-Coach Masha formed the coaching team for the 2025 Jessup International Law Moot Court Competition.

They hold the selection of the 2025 KMA Jessup team in June 2025. The new team united 3/4 2024 Telders Champions Team and one new team member with previous experience in Price Media Moot Court.



# Team History & Achievements

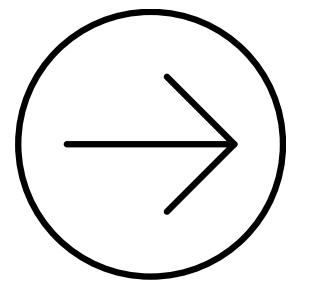
## Achievements

On 31 January - 2 February 2025 the team competed with 5 other law schools at the Ukrainian National Rounds. We became the first team from NaUKMA ever to **win all the nominations at the National Rounds:**

- National Champion;
- Best Memorials;
- Best Oralist - Vladyslav Levchuk (with unbelievable 96,73/100 points)
- 2nd Best Oralist - Anastasiia Shashkevych
- 3rd Best Oralist - Bohdana Yaruta

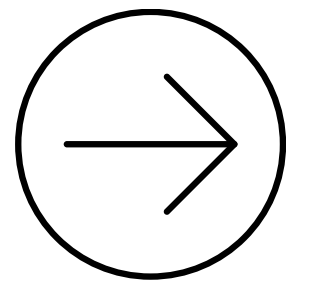

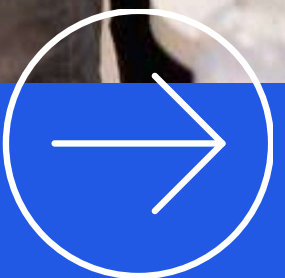

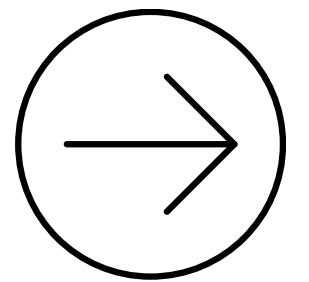
## History & Achievements

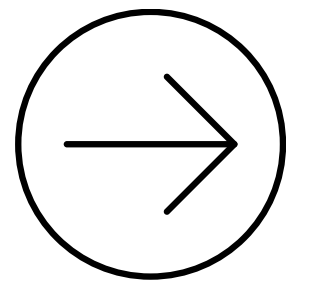

Not everyone can go to D.C. - only the National Champions and in rare cases more teams can represent their country

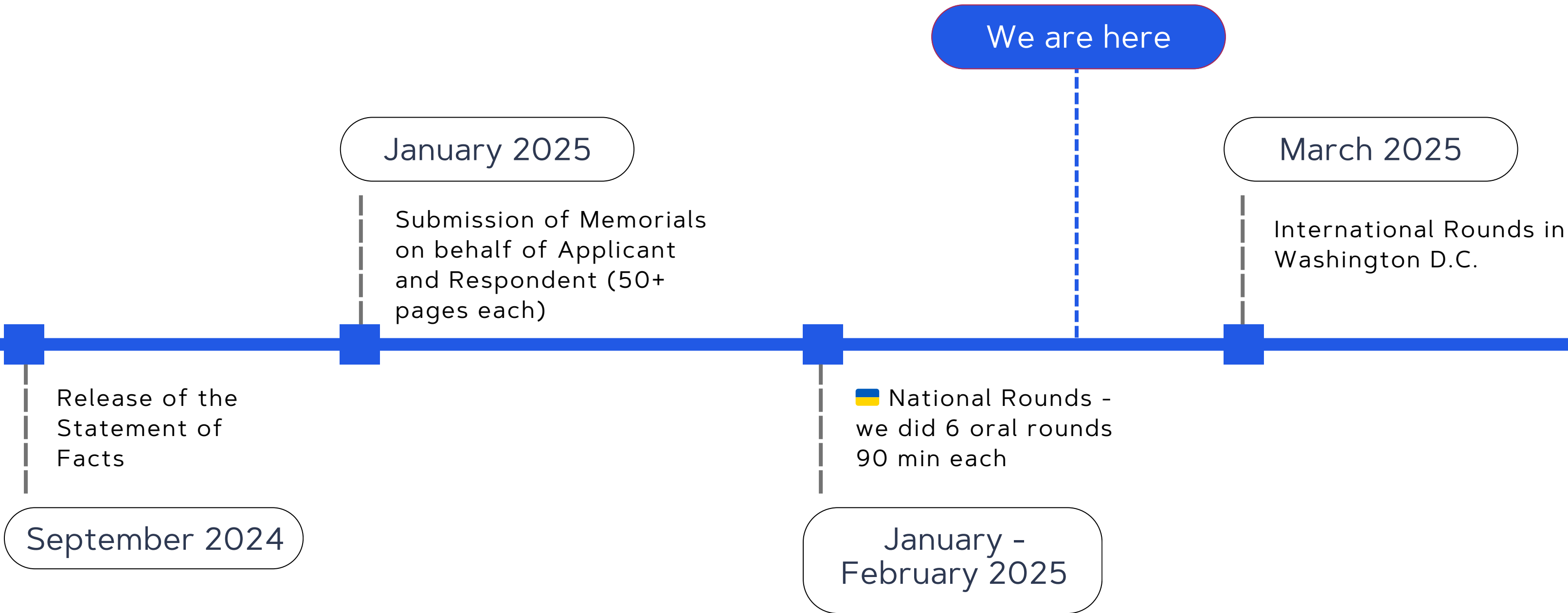
## 02 Public International Law & ICJ

Will be held in Washington D.C. on 29 March - 5 April 2025.

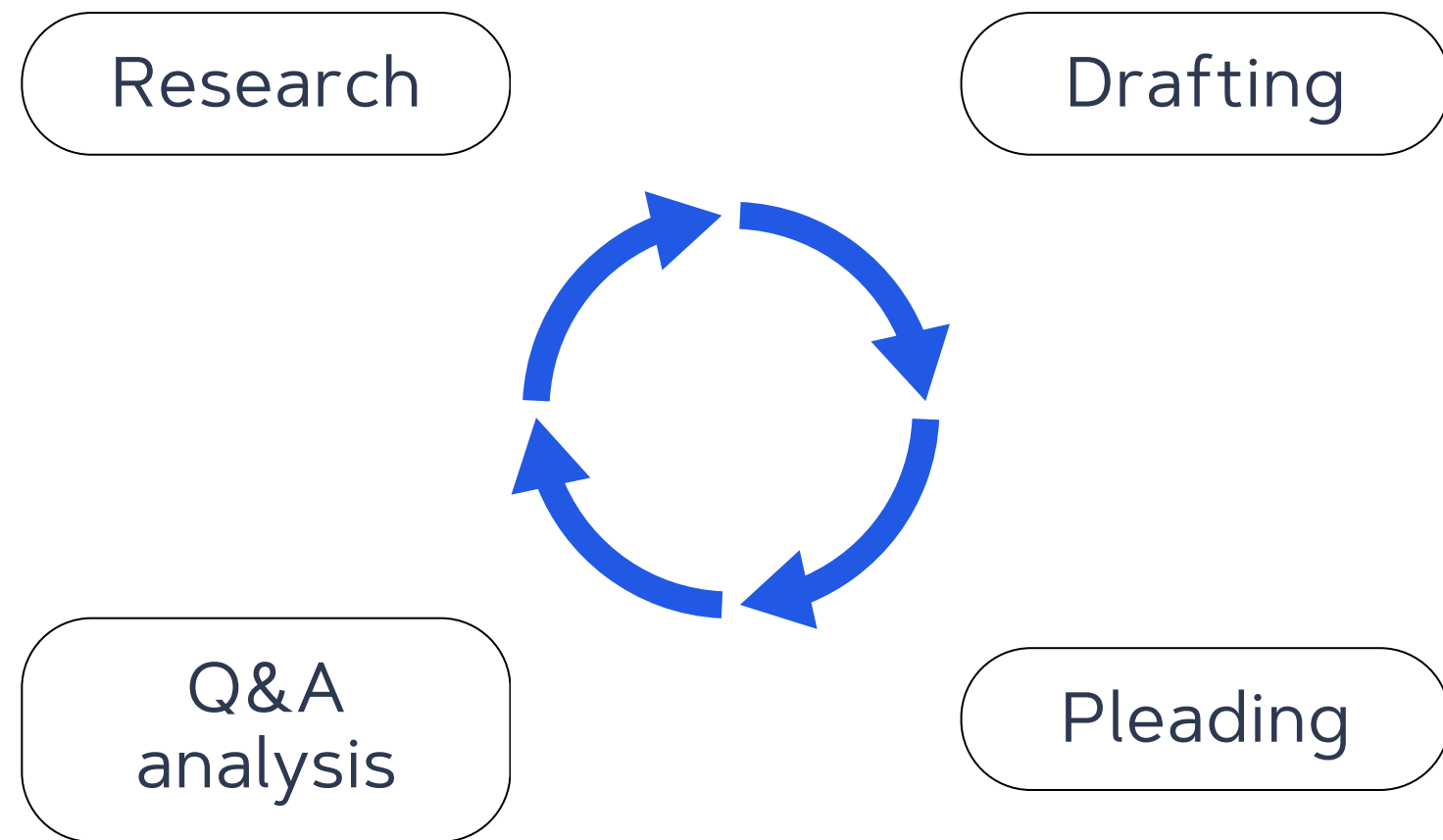
# Road to D.C.



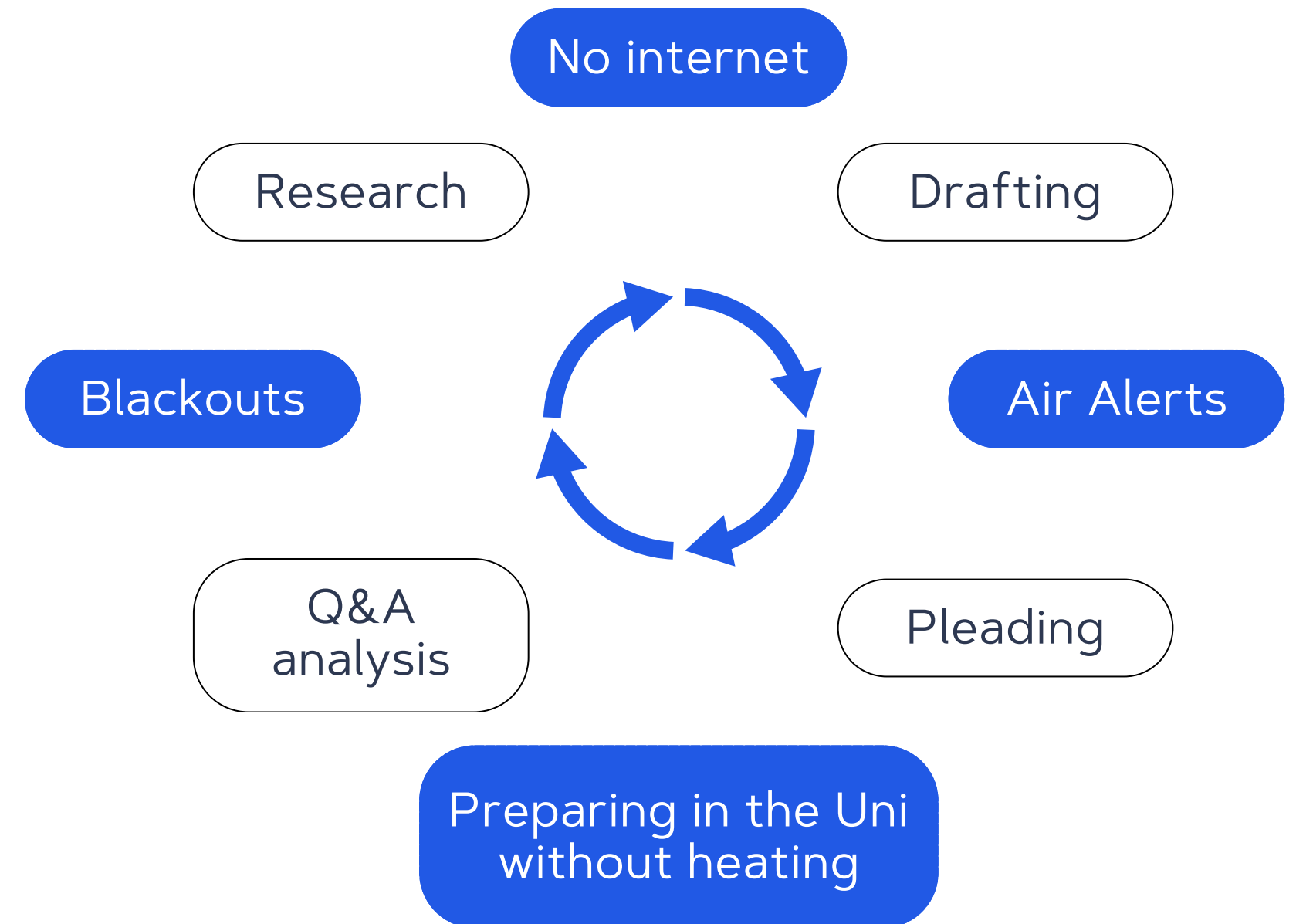
# What does the Road to D.C. look like?

**There were 2122 air alerts in 2024 in Kharkiv region and 1172 air alerts in 2024 in the Kyiv region.  
There were weeks when electricity was for 6-10 hours per day.**

We work with victims of the war crimes and we've learned that justice is their only hope when they lost everything and sometimes the beloved people. We want to have skills and knowledge to help them get justice.

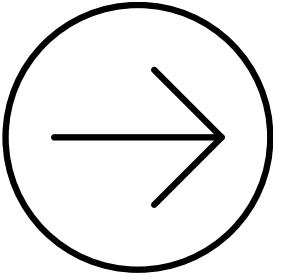
