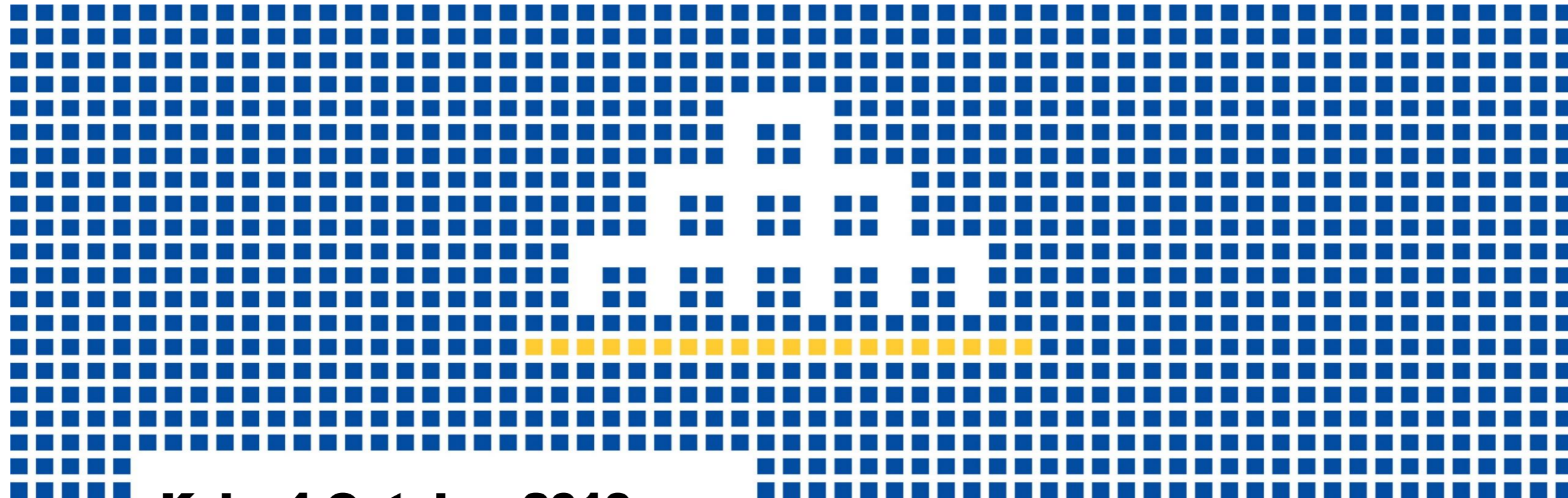

PRAVO-JUSTICE FINAL REPORT

LEGISLATIVE AMENDMENTS TO THE CODES

- **AMENDMENTS TO BLACK LETTER LAW SHOULD NOT OCCUR ON A REGULAR BASIS**
- **JUDGES AND LAWYERS NEED A STABLE LEGISLATIVE ENVIRONMENT**
- **NECESSARY AMENDMENTS SHOULD BE PREPARED IN CONSULTATION WITH JUDGES, LAWYERS AND COURT USERS (E.G. INTERNET CONSULTATIONS)**
- **AMENDMENTS SHOULD BE ACCOMPANIED BY EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM PLUS TIME FOR GETTING FAMILIAR WITH THE NEW RULES**
