

## PRAVO-JUSTICE FINAL REPORT LEGISLATIVE AMENDMENTS TO THE CODES

- AMENDMENTS TO BLACK LETTER LAW SHOULD <u>NOT</u> OCCUR ON A REGULAR BASIS
- JUDGES AND LAWYERS NEED A STABLE LEGISLATIVE ENVIRONMENT
- NECESSARY AMENDMENTS SHOULD BE PREPARED IN CONSULTATION WITH JUDGES, LAWYERS AND COURT USERS (E.G. INTERNET CONSULTATIONS)
- AMENDMENTS SHOULD BE ACCOMPANIED BY EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM PLUS TIME FOR GETTING FAMILIAR WITH THE NEW RULES
